Course Overview

This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in aged services; either in residential, home or community based environments. Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery. Workers may be required to demonstrate leadership and have limited responsibility for the organisation and the quantity and quality of outputs of others within limited parameters.



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Job Opportunities

Job roles that may be available to you after successful completion of the course include:

- » Aged Care Activity Worker
- » Care Service Team Leader
- » Care Supervisor (Aged Care)

Entry Requirements

1. Students must be 18 years of age or over.
2. Students are required to successfully complete the Language Literacy and Numeracy test and achieve Level 3 in the Australian Core Skills Framework across reading, writing, learning, oral communication and numeracy skill. Prospective International students who provide an IELTS of 5.5 or its equivalent will be deemed as meeting the English language entry requirements.
3. Satisfactorily complete a pre-training review interview to determine student's suitability for the chosen course.
4. Students are required to be physically fit to carry out some tasks as required by the course.
5. Students are required to have access to a computer and internet in order to complete assessments and read information on the units of competency.

Work Placement

To gain this qualification, successful completion of at least **120 hours work placement** is required at an accredited aged care facility. Students will be informed of this at the interview.

The RTO will assist with the process of gaining work placement in an accredited/approved facility, you will be required to complete a referral form with either 3, 5 or 7 referrals of facilities in your local area. The RTO will communicate with the accredited/approved facility on your behalf to engage the facilities on your behalf to complete your work placement hours. The RTO will ensure the facilities meet workplace requirements for your supervision and insurance in the workplace.

NOTE: THIS IS NOT PAID WORK.

Students will be required to pay additional costs associated with work placements including:

- Work placement fee may be charged by the host employer (if applicable)
- Uniforms for participation in workplace: Long black pants, black enclosed shoes
